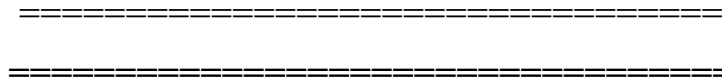

June Meeting

General meeting is at Lynchburg College, Thursday, June 15, 7:00 PM.

The May meeting at **Lynchburg College, room 209 Centennial Hall** will begin with a general discussion and Q&A session at 7:00 p.m. followed by the featured presentation. During the Q&A session we'll have a silent slide show of some of the sights from Bolivia and Peru captured by your roaming president, Michael Corbin, some of them at the very moment y'all were meeting last month.

This month's topic will be two parts: (1) further discussion of the future, and (2) a presentation from PeachPit Press Meeting-in-a-Box titled "Tiger Tips and Tricks." And yes, Virginia, there are freebies to give away.



Centennial Hall directions

Last month's meeting was moved at the last minute from Hopwood Hall to Centennial Hall due to the closure of Hopwood for construction. Hopwood is the oldest building on the LC campus, and Centennial the newest, so in a number of ways, this is an upgrade for us, but it will likely call for a different access strategy for members. Centennial is located between the campus library and the chapel, with parking behind and beside. To drive there most directly, you will probably want to use the LC main gate as a reference. This is located off Lakeside Drive, and however you get there, DON'T turn into the main gate. There is a traffic light on Lakeside about 50 yards from the LC drive, and if you reach the LC drive first, continue to the traffic light and turn right there instead. If you are on lakeside and reach the traffic light BEFORE you get to LC's drive, turn left at the light. If you reach the light from Old Forest Road instead of Lakeside Drive, go straight at the light.

All these will run you alongside one LCs athletic fields, and you will want to turn right at the first opportunity. That street goes uphill behind the college chapel, and if you turn right again when forced to do so, just after passing the back of the chapel, you'll find yourself headed for one of the parking lots between the chapel and Centennial with the latter on your left. You can also park behind the chapel, although there is a little bit of hill to climb, and there is a small parking lot across the street behind Centennial Hall. If worse comes to worst, it is also possible to park on the far side of the library, on down the street behind Centennial Hall.
